

ORDINANCE NO. 1-94
IMPROPER EXHIBITIONS

The Town Board of the Town of Edgewater does ordain as follows:

The purpose of this ordinance is to provide a means of control over improper exhibitions.

This ordinance is adopted as authorized under s. 66.035 Wis Stats.

It shall be unlawful for any person to perform, or for any licensee or manager or agent of the licensee to permit any employee, entertainer or patron to engage in any live act, demonstration, dance or exhibition on the licensed premises which:

- 1) Exposes his or her genitals, pubic hair, buttocks, perineum, anal region or pubic hair region; or
- 2) Exposes any device, costume or covering which give the appearance of or simulates genitals, public hair, buttocks, perineum, anal region or pubic hair region or;
- 3) Exposes any portion of the female breast at or below the areola thereof; or
- 4) Engages in or simulates sexual intercourse and/or any sexual contact, including the touching of any portion of the female breast or the male and/or female genitals.

This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, publication and recording according to law.

Page 1, Penalties for violation of this ordinance may be assessed as follows.

- A. Any person, business, partnership, corporation or other legal entity.
- (1) first violation of any provision of this ordinance shall forfeit not more than \$500.
 - (2) second violation of any provision of this ordinance within one year may have a suspension of alcohol beverage license granted by the Edgewater town board for a period of 90 days, with a risk of complete forfeiture of alcohol beverage license, or a forfeit not more than \$1000.
 - (3) third and subsequent violation of any provision of this ordinance within one year may result in the revocation of alcohol beverage license granted by the Edgewater town board, or a forfeiture of not more than \$1500.
- B. Each violation may be considered a separate offense under this ordinance.
- C. Any person, business, partnership, corporation or other legal entity that fails to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction pay a forfeiture plus applicable surcharges, assessments and costs for each violation. In addition, the town may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.
