

ORDINANCE NO. 3-94  
PARKING ORDINANCE

This ordinance is entitled the Town of Edgewater Parking Ordinance. The purpose of this ordinance is to allow safe passage of vehicles on town roads.

The Town Board of Edgewater has the specific statutory authority, powers and duties, to regulate, control, prevent and enforce against, in the Town of Edgewater certain uses, activities, businesses and operations by persons that may affect the traffic in the Town of Edgewater.


The Town Board of the Town of Edgewater establishes this ordinance for parking upon streets where stopping or parking is authorized or permitted. A vehicle is not lawfully stopped or parked unless it complies with the following requirement:

- (a) Upon a street where traffic is permitted to move in both directions simultaneously without obstruction and where angle parking is not clearly designated by official traffic signs or markers, a vehicle must be parked parallel to the edge of the street heading in the direction of traffic on the right side of the road.

Any person violating this ordinance may be required to forfeit not less than \$20.00 nor more than \$40.00 for the first offense and not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$100.00 for the 2nd or subsequent conviction within a year.

This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, publication and recording according to law.
