

TOWN OF EDGEWATER
ORDINANCE #1-95

Prohibiting the use of road right of way or the road for piling and loading of logs or other wood products.

The Town Board of the Town of Edgewater, Sawyer County, State of Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person or company to pile logs, bolts, or other wood products on the road or the road right of way, or to use the road or road right of way for loading and or unloading logs, bolts, or other wood products.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person or company to have more than one entrance off of the road, per one fourth (1/4) mile; unless the entrance is to be used for a dwelling sight.

Section 3: Penalty; any person or company violating this ordinance, in any part, shall be liable for damages to the road or the road right of way and shall pay the cost of repairing the road or road right of way to its original condition. Even if no damage is done to the road or right of way, there shall be a fine of \$250.00 for the first offense, the second violation and subsequent violations of this ordinance shall be \$500.00 per violation.

Section 4: The Town Board for the Town of Edgewater, Sawyer County, has final authority on all points of this ordinance.


Section 5: This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication and recording according to law.

Section 6: This ordinance supersedes all other ordinances on this topic.


