

# Town of Edgewater

## ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ROUTE ORDINANCE #2005-6

These routes shall be open to All-Terrain vehicles from April 15<sup>th</sup> through November 15<sup>th</sup> of each year this ordinance is in effect.

1. That the following named roads in the Town of Edgewater shall be designated as All-Terrain vehicle routes between those areas posted as such with All-Terrain route signs:


- (a) Summit Lake Road from Chapel Road north .25 miles. (1/4)
- (b) East Shore Road from Scenic Road Intersection .10 miles. (1/10)
- (c) Scenic Road from East Shore Road Intersection, 3 miles, ending at Wooddale Road. (3)
- (d) Sunset Lane from State Hwy 48 to the Tuscobia State Trail. (4/10 mile)
- (e) Sunset Beach Drive from State Hwy 48 to its north end. (8/10 mile)
- (f) Stony Hill Road from County Road F east 3 miles to Trail 31 No. (3)

All-terrain vehicles are allowed to travel only on the routes that are marked for All-terrain vehicle travel by fluorescent green signs. The Town of Edgewater shall not be liable for the purchase and placement of these signs. The Birchwood ATV Club shall be liable for the purchase, placement and up keep of such signs. All-terrain vehicle travel is only allowed within the signed area. Operators age 18 and under shall wear helmets while operating an All-terrain vehicle. Operators age 16 and under shall have participated in a safety class and have on their person a certificate stating they passed the safety and operating training. See s.23.33 WI State Statutes for all applicable laws.

- 2. The speed limit shall be 15 miles per hour while operating on all Town of Edgewater roads. State law restricts All-terrain vehicle speed to 10 mph within 150 feet of a dwelling between the hours of 10:30 pm and 7:00 am.
- 3. All-terrain vehicles shall operate on the extreme right side of the roadway and travel with the flow of traffic.
- 4. All-terrain vehicles shall be operated in single file.
- 5. All-terrain vehicle operators shall yield the right-of-way to all other vehicular traffic and pedestrians.
- 6. Headlights shall be turned on and in working order at all times while operating on the roadway or shoulder.
- 7. Operators of All-terrain vehicles violating any of the above conditions shall be subject to the underlying violation of illegally operating on the roadway.
- 8. Operators of All-terrain vehicles travel at their own risk. The Town of Edgewater shall not be liable for any damages or injuries to operators of All-terrain vehicles occurring in the Town of Edgewater.
- 9. The Birchwood Police Department, Sawyer County Sheriffs Department, and the Department of Natural Resources are hereby designated as the law enforcement agencies responsible for the enforcement of the provisions of this ordinance.
- 10. The penalty for violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance is the same as listed in s. 23.33, Wis. Stats. as adopted by reference.

11. This Ordinance shall be effective for two (2) years upon passage and publication as provided by law and shall repeal and replace all previous All-terrain vehicle ordinance heretofore enacted by the Town of Edgewater, and shall lapse unless reauthorized by the Town Board.


