

**Ordinance 2010-1 to Lower Speed Limits on  
Town Roads and Highways  
Town of Edgewater - Sawyer County, Wisconsin**

**SECTION 1 – AUTHORITY**

The Town Board of the Town of Edgewater, Sawyer County, Wisconsin has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wisconsin Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

**SECTION 2 – RESEARCH**

A traffic and engineering investigation having been made on the following described highways, the maximum permissible speed at which vehicles may be operated on said highways, which speed is herewith established as reasonable and safe pursuant to Section 349.11 Wisconsin Statutes, shall be as set forth herein subject to approval by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, and upon the erection of standard signs giving notice thereof.

**SECTION 3 -- ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE**

This Ordinance adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain Town Roads and Highways in the Town as follows:

A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., effective on the date of adoption listed below, speed limits on certain Town of Edgewater Roads are reduced or modified as follows:

1. East Shore Drive from 500 feet south of Ol' Hayes Road north to Chapel Road the maximum speed limit shall be 35 mph.
2. Wooddale Road from State Highway 48 to north 0.7 miles the maximum speed limit shall be 25 mph.
3. Cedar Avenue from County Highway F east to Creek Lane the maximum speed limit shall be 45 mph.
4. Hillside Lane from County Highway DD south to the termination of Hillside Lane the maximum speed limit shall be 25 mph.
5. Green Lake Road from County Highway F north to Little Sissabagama Road the maximum speed shall be 35 mph.
6. Little Sissabagama Road from Green Lake Road to the north Town Line the maximum speed shall be 35 mph.

B. Pursuant to s. 349.11(5), Wis. Stats., the Town Chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above described locations on or before the effective date of this Ordinance.

C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above noted Town Roads in violation of the above noted speed limits. Any violations shall be subject to penalties under s.346.60, Wis. Stats.

This Ordinance is effective on posting by the Town Clerk as required under s.60.80, Wis. Stats.
